Guidelines and Safety Protocols for Learn to Skate Program

Everyone using the facility will be expected to follow these safety procedures and abide by them. Please check our website for any changes/updates to the procedures. Guidelines may be updated in accordance with State regulations.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Please ENTER AND EXIT the facility as marked. There is one entrance on the parking lot side of building (Magoo's side). You must exit through the door in the main lobby.
- Please do not come to class if you or your skater is exhibiting any symptoms of Covid-19, or are not feeling well. We reserve the right to perform temperature checks before getting on the ice.
- Skaters/chaperones may only enter the hallway of the arena from the SIDE ENTRANCE and may not enter the building until 10 min before your assigned skate time. This will allow for an earlier group to leave the building.
- Skaters need to come into arena fully dressed and with skates already on (with skate guards). NO LOCKER ROOMS are being used at this time.
- Only 1 chaperone is allowed in the building per skater. Chaperones must socially distance if they stay in arena during skater's class. Masks must be worn whenever inside the building.
- Skate guards, once taken off, MUST be kept with chaperone.
- Once the scheduled session has ended, skaters will be escorted off the ice surface as quickly as possible, for pick up by a chaperone. You also must leave the lobby/building within 10 minutes of your scheduled ice. This will allow for safe distancing of the skate group that is waiting in the hallway for their ice time. Please be respectful of this rule to keep the rink on schedule for all groups.

CLASS INFORMATION

- All skaters will receive a name sticker and a color code for their assigned class.
- Instructors will take attendance each week at the start of class so you do not need to "check-in" each week, after your first class of the session.
- Skaters will stay with their assigned class for the entire session. (Older children who have practice time will stay with their assigned class during the practice portion on the lesson.)
- The ice will have designated class areas to keep classes at a safe distance.
- Parents must provide a valid phone number and email address with their registration in case of emergency.
